

I-CORD COLLABORATORS MEETING



The I-CORD project is an audit of births to assess current practices for management of the third stage of labour, and for care at the time of birth for preterm infants in low and middle income countries. Audit of births is done to assess whether conducting a second proposed large multicentre randomised trial comparing different policies for timing of cord clamping at preterm births would be possible in low and middle income settings. I-CORD held a collaborators meeting on 21st march 2016 in Kampala Uganda. The countries that participated in the audit include Kenya, Uganda, Pakistan, India and UK. The meeting brought all the collaborators from the countries together. The Nottingham Clinical Trials Unit presented the preliminary data which was to go through further analysis and prepared for publication.
